Caleb Dodson was born in Fauquier Co., Virginia in 1782 and while a resident of Halifax County, Virginia was drafted 3/1776 into Capt. Peter Rodgers' company. Colonel's Barton and Burells Regiment. Was in the battle of Stone and was discharged at that place in the winter of 1791. He served under Capt. Hopsen at Point on Bare River. Dept. of Interior, Bureau of Pensions Washington, D. C.
